

**GE UNIT AND ITS EMPLOYEES DONATE \$20,000 TO CHILD GUIDANCE CENTER
AND PERSON-TO-PERSON**

STAMFORD, CT/March 8, 2007 – The Child Guidance Center of Southern Connecticut and Person-to-Person have received \$20,000 in donations from GE Energy Financial Services, proceeds from the business’ year-end holiday event. The donations were the combined contributions of GE Energy Financial Services’ employees and the GE business’ matching gift.

The Child Guidance Center will use the donation to support its Child and Family Therapy Program. This program provides professional mental health services to help youngsters overcome traumatic life circumstances and psychiatric symptoms that interfere with functioning and threaten a healthy development.
