CHILD GUIDANCE CENTER ANNOUNCES NEW CARE COORDINATOR

STAMFORD, CT/October 27, 2009 – The Child Guidance Center of Southern Connecticut (CGC) has announced the appointment of Migdalia Rodriguez of Norwalk as Care Coordinator in the System of Care program. Rodriguez will provide intensive case management services to families of seriously emotionally disturbed children.

Prior to CGC, Rodriguez served as a Bilingual Family Violence Victims Advocate for the Domestic Violence Crisis Center in Stamford. She also worked as a Bilingual/Multicultural Counselor and Outreach Advocate for the Sexual Assault Crisis and Education Center in Stamford. Rodriguez earned a Bachelor's degree in General Studies from the University of Connecticut.

The Child Guidance Center of Southern Connecticut is a non-profit mental health resource, serving children and teenagers in Stamford, Greenwich, Darien and New Canaan, both self referred and through referrals from schools, physicians, courts, and public and private human service agencies, and physicians. CGC's clinical staff of psychiatrists, psychologists, social workers, and marriage and family therapists work with more than 2,300 children annually. Preventative services are provided to youngsters, parents, and professionals through community education and consultation programs. Incorporated in 1954, CGC is supported by the Connecticut Department of Children & Families, Connecticut Office of Victim Crime Services, United Ways of Greenwich and Western Connecticut, The Community Fund of Darien, and the New Canaan Community Foundation.
