CHILD GUIDANCE CENTER ANNOUNCES NEW CASE MANAGER

STAMFORD, CT/March 27, 2009 – The Child Guidance Center of Southern Connecticut (CGC) has announced that Jonathan Moran of Trumbull has joined the staff as a case manager. Moran will work with service providers to facilitate case coordination and will refer children and families to appropriate community agencies.

Prior to joining CGC, Moran worked for two years at the Alternative Incarceration Center in Stamford, Conn., where he served as a bilingual case manager for individuals involved in the criminal justice system. He also served as a group provider for the Substance Abuse Group and Reasons and Rehabilitation II-r for both English and Spanish-speaking clients.

Moran holds a bachelor's degree in Human Service and Education from the University of Bridgeport. He is currently pursuing a master's degree in Human Service and Counseling from his alma mater.

The Child Guidance Center of Southern Connecticut is a non-profit mental health resource, serving children and teenagers in Stamford, Greenwich, Darien, and New Canaan, both self referred and through referrals from schools, courts, human service agencies, and physicians. The CGC's clinical staff of psychiatrists, psychologists, social workers, and marriage and family therapists work with more than 2,100 children annually, providing culturally competent and sensitive care to families representative of the rich ethnic mix of communities CGC serves. Preventative services are provided to youngsters, parents, and professionals through public education and consultation programs. Incorporated in 1954, the CGC is supported by the Connecticut Department of Children & Families, Connecticut Office of Victim Crime Services and United Ways of Greenwich, New Canaan and Western Connecticut, the Community Fund of Darien as well as generous individual, foundation, and corporate contributions.
